Milk and Wine Lily (Pink and White) (*Crinum scabrum*) Seeds

PLANT IMMEDIATELY. DO NOT STORE

Blooms mainly in spring and fall, but may bloom during the summer, as well, with white and pink striped blooms.

Planting Instructions:

Press seed down into loosened, well draining soil so about ½ of the seed is above soil line. (Add orchid mix, vermiculite or coarse sand to regular potting mix to make it well draining). Keep in a bright area, but not direct sunlight, at 72° F or warmer. Keep soil evenly moist, but not soggy, until germination in about 30 days; best watered from bottom as seeds are light & will float. May start seeds in garden or in pots; if in pots, use a pot deep enough for bulb to form (5"-6"). Seedling will create the bulb first, then leaves.

Seeds need to be planted when fresh, they will not store.

Small plants may be kept indoors in pots over winter, if needed.

DAYS TO GERMINATION: 30

FINAL SPACING: 12"-15"

GROWS BEST IN: FULL SUN or PART SHADE, Small plants are best kept in mostly shade for several months and slowly acclimatized to full sun.

PLANT IN AVERAGE, WELL DRAINING, SANDY SOIL. Do not let water stand on these bulbs.

HARDY TO: USDA Zone 8: 15° F
